FIRST AID PROCESS

NO PARENTS, SPECTATORS OR UNAUTHORISED VOLUNTEERS TO ENTER THE FIELD

Injury Requiring Medical Attention:

- First Aider and Manager to attend injured player
- Follow DRSABC steps
- If necessary, request umpire to stop play to ensure safety
- If minor injury remove player safely from field
- First Aider to attend to injured player off the field
- Refer player for medical assessment if necessary

Head Injury/Concussion

- First Aider and Manager to attend injured player
- Follow DRSABC step
- Use the HeadCheck App and follow recommendations
- If no suspected head or spinal injury remove player safely from field
- If player has suspected concussion, player is not to return to play
- First Aider to send HeadCheck information to parent and recommend to seek medical assessment
- If confirmed concussion, player must adhere to AFL Concussion Management Guidelines

Suspected Spinal or Neck Injury

- First Aider and Manager to attend to injured player
- Follow DRSABC steps
- If suspected spinal or neck injury CALL 000
- Keep player comfortable, support neck
- DO NOT move and DO NOT use neck brace
- Liaise with umpires and parents regarding stopping the game until ambulance arrives
